The show will feature musicians and dancers from the **Boston Tango Society**. They will perform several versions of the art form, style, and rhythm as they were enjoyed during the tango's golden age of 1920's to 1960's (tango, milonga, waltz, candombe).

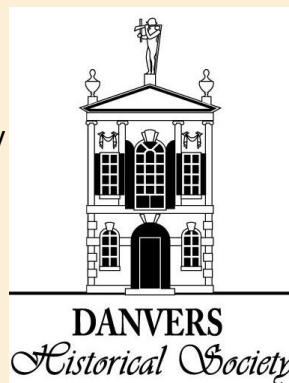
