All you need to know to Donate a Tree or Wreath

How It works:

- 1. Fill out front of Participation Form- by Nov. 4th to donate a tree or wreath and secure a spot
 - Online fillable form at DanversHistory.org or downloadable pdf
 - Email to dhsparadeoftrees@gmail.com
 - Or Mail to Danvers Historical Society, PO Box 381, Danvers, MA 01923
- 2. Fill out back of Participation Form- no later than Nov. 21st for committee to prepare your description and add it to your display
- 3. Buy or create artificial holiday tree or wreath. We welcome all winter holiday celebrations.
 - Display size Up to 6 ft. tall, 3 ft. wide
 - Wreath size Up to 2 ft. in diameter
 - **Lights** white or colored, preferably LED lights
 - Tree and wreath accessories Suitable tree or tabletop tree stand, wreath hanger, tree skirt or covering
- 4. Pick a theme i.e. Art, Music, Sports, Gardening, Traditional holiday, Dinosaurs, etc.
 - Name your display e.g. A Colorful Christmas, Surfs Up!, Winter Woodland
 - **Decorate** to interpret your theme
 - Include (but not required) gifts and/or certificates
 - Valuables Items are kept in a locked environment
 - Prohibited loose glitter, confetti, artificial snow, real food items
 - Actual gifts/certificates decorate with copies
 - Valuables or edible gifts represent with a facsimile, a picture, or mock item

5. Set up your Display

Where: Tapley Memorial Hall, 13 Page St, Danvers, MA

• When: Friday November 21 10 AM - 4 PM

Saturday November 22 Noon – 4 PM Monday November 24 10 AM – 4 PM

We will contact you to schedule your set up day/time after we receive your participation form.

• **Bring** all display items (stands, hangers, lights, ornaments, ornament hooks, gifts/certificates, etc.) and setup in areas designated for displays

We will collect gifts and certificates that are to be put in our secure location and help will be available if needed. **Tapley Memorial Hall** only accepts 40 trees and 10 wreaths. Displays are arranged to look their best within the event space.
