Feb 26 Great Molasses Disaster. 2.3 million gallons (12,000 tons) rushed through the streets at 35mph

Apr 23 Construction and Consequence of Quabbin Reservoir displacement of 2,500 people and flooding of four towns

Jun 25 Earnest Shackleton's Antarctic Voyage Experience from August 1914 to June 1916.

Aug 27 The discovery and display of Paul Revere and John Adams artifacts discovered in a Mass. Statehouse Time Capsule

Oct 22 The Blizzard of 78, the area's most significant snowstorm. "Storm Larry" dropped over 27 inches of snow.
